





Research technician position at the Institute of Environmental Sciences and Technology (ICTA-UAB) in the "BlueIslands" project.

BLUEISLANDS a 3-year European project (2016-2019) co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund, within the framework of the Interreg MED Programme 2014-2020. The partnership consists of 14 partners (the ICTA-UAB is the coordinator of the Working Package 3), including 9 Mediterranean islands, 2 economic operators, 2 research institutions and an international association specialised in resource management.

The project will work on developing and elaborating effective, financially viable and environmentally responsible means to address the seasonal variation of waste generation on MED islands due to tourism.

The Institute of Environmental Science and Technology at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (ICTA-UAB) offers a Research Technician position, for the operational technical intervention specialized in the extraction and analysis of microplastic samples, within the framework of BlueIslands project.

Oualifications

Candidates must hold the Certificate of Higher Education (FPII), General Certificate of Education (Batxillerat), or equivalent. It will be taken into account to have obtained the Degree in Environmental Sciences, and the work experience in the analysis of samples. Candidates must prove their ability to communicate fluently in English.

Contract terms

This is a three-month contract. The contract will start on 16th October 2017

The monthly gross salary is 1.101'60 €. The work period is from Monday to Friday, from 9 AM to 1 PM (20 hours a week).

Application procedure

The application should include a current Curriculum Vitae of the applicant, copy of the academic certificate and the documentation proving the alleged merits.
