

ICTASS 2019 FAQs

1. What are the requirements for submitting to ICTASS2019 as an author?

Eligible authors are PhD students, academic staff and Postdoc scientists with less than 5 years of post-doctoral experience working at ICTA-UAB and willing to review an abstract from a colleague.

2. What are the main requirements for abstract submission?

- To present results that have not yet been presented at ICTA-UAB;
- Max 500 words;
- Author's bio of max 150 words;
- Follow the guidelines and the template

3. How many abstract submissions can be sent?

One!

4. How will the reviewers be chosen?

Each abstract will receive two reviews: one from a researcher not from the same field and another from a senior from the same field. By fields we mean the two broad categories of natural and social science.

5. Which criteria will be used to assign accepted abstracts to either oral or poster presentations?

Time and space restrictions will be taken into account, in relation to the number of submissions received. Also, we aim to achieve balance between different groups and to prioritize presenters in their final years at ICTA.

6. How much time do we have for poster/oral presentation?

POSTER: there will be a time slot (whose duration will depend on the number of accepted posters) in which the audience will be divided into small groups (8-10 people each), each provided with instructions for taking a "posters tour". So, every author will get the chance to present his/her poster to the different groups for 5 minutes each.

ORAL: 15 minutes, including questions and answers (ideally 10 minutes of presentation + 5 minutes of open discussion).

7. How does the feedback/vote system work?

There is the possibility to evaluate both poster and oral presentations, as well as the Spring Symposium as a whole. Additionally, it will be possible to vote on the clarity and soundness of the content, as well as the visual design and ability in presenting. In addition, open suggestions for improvement will be welcome.

8. What are the prizes?

Funding for publishing in an open access journal or for presenting at an international conference.
